# TILAWAH AL-QURAN

Please recite from the following verses:

1. Surah Al-Jumuah (verses 10-12)

Competition rules:

1. Melodious recitation with the correct tajweed
2. No need to memorize the verses
3. Participants must recite with the text in front of them to prevent mistakes with the text of the Quran
